- Organise a follow-up workshop in course of 2010
- Provide a report by the end of 2010 to DG RTD with recommendations on R&D needs
- Represent the Task Force and report to Pilot Coordination Committee
- Explore opportunities of R&D projects for members

2/ 2010 mission of Task Force leader “Membrane technologies for water applications”

- Coordinate the activities with the Task Force members and with the Water Cluster of the European Membrane House
- Organise at least one workshop in the first semester of 2010
- Provide a joint WsstP / EMH report by the end of 2010 to DG RTD with recommendations on R&D needs
- Represent the Task Force and report to Pilot Coordination Committee
- Explore opportunities of R&D projects for members
